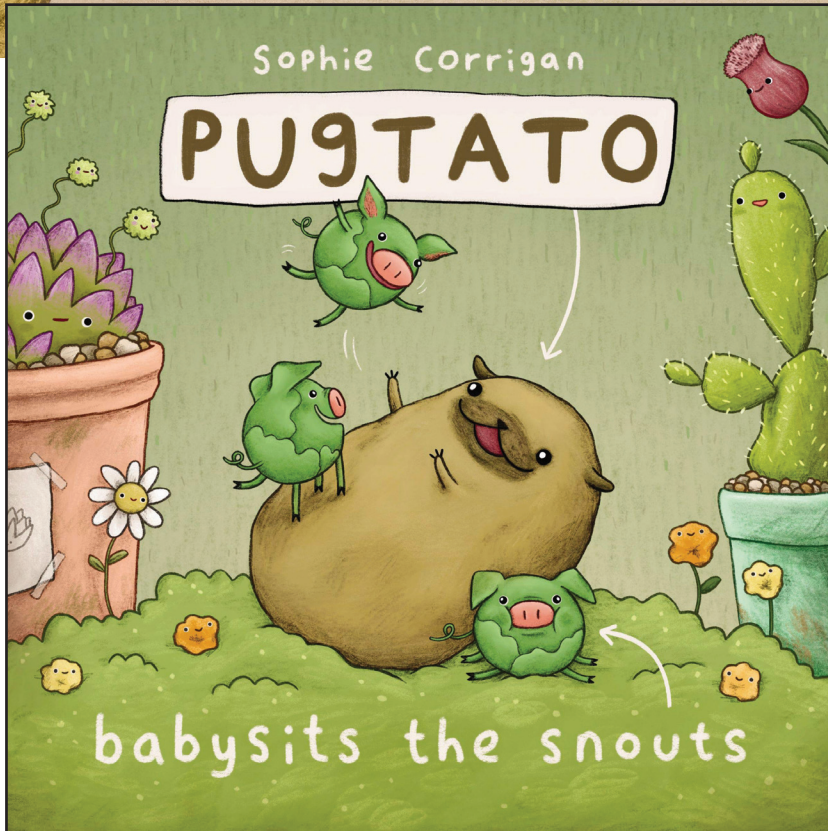

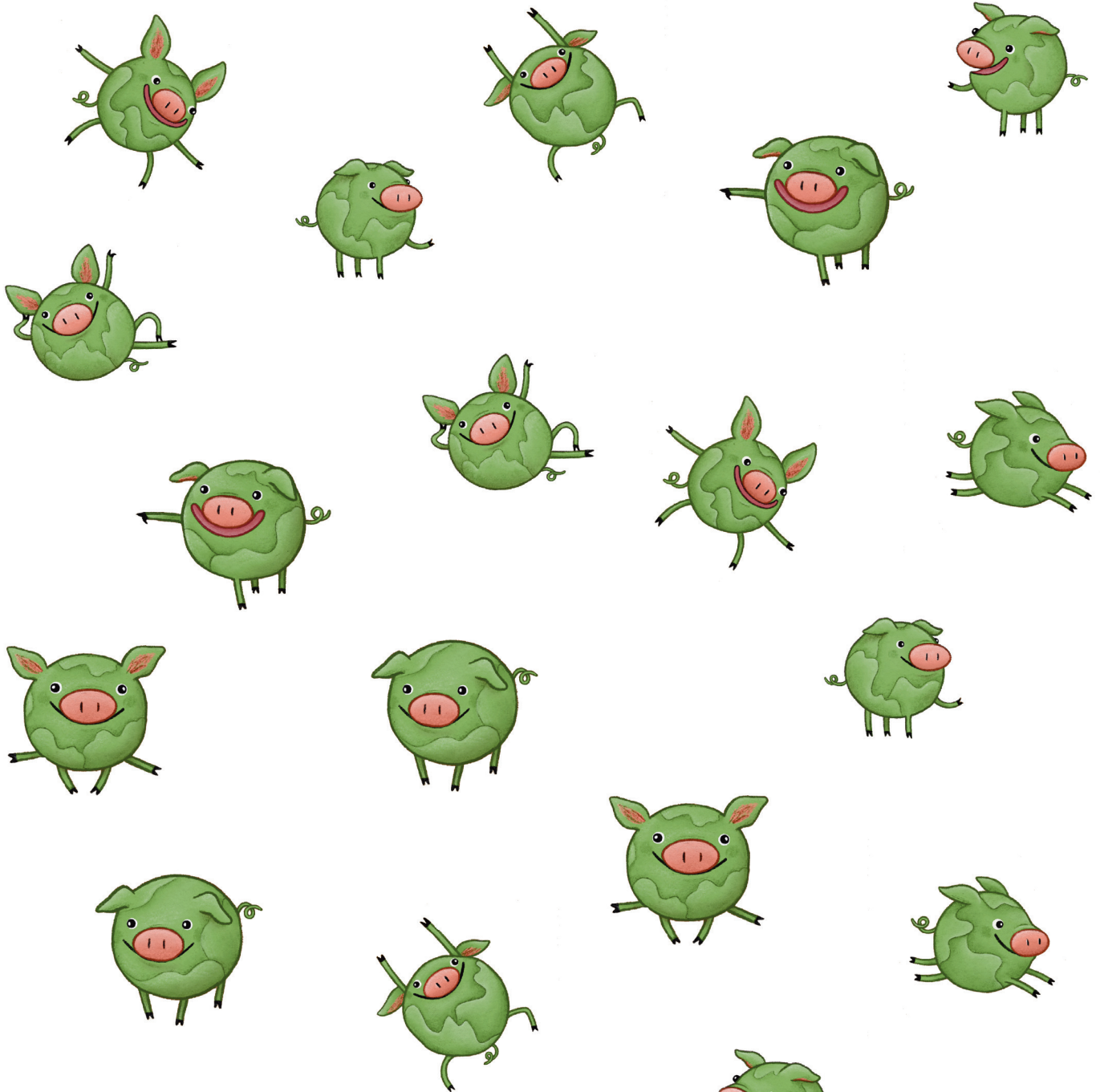
Paint the Pot
